COMPETITION RATING

Category A = Club teams which train year long at a very serious elite playing or national team level.

Category B = Club teams which train year long, but which might not always be fully talented. Level of play will be consistently good, but not necessarily great.

Category C = Teams are comprised of local teams which are not so strong, and/or teams which are comprised of individual campers from basketball camp. Level of play can be good, fair, or inconsistent.

NBA GUESTS

It is probable you will be on a tour, which gets to meet and listen to an NBA guest player or coach. Look at the ABN website for the specific updated tournament information. Many times we do not know which player we will secure until Christmas.

INFO FOR INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS

If you sign up as an individual, you will be assigned a coach with minimum college and/or international experience. ABN hires only top coaches to instruct individuals going to our international tournaments. You are guaranteed placement or your deposit back in September. Your coach will chaperone your entire tour.

TEAM SIGNUPS

Their own coach will coach teams that sign up. However, it will be difficult to beat the prices EFTOURS can offer. Teams pay a site tournament fee as well as a per head fee for incidentals, tee shirt, and exchange buffer. These events are not cheap to put on with the dollar as weak as it is! Teams may choose coaching salary credit in lieu of coach's payment.

TOURNAMENT FORMATS

FIBA international rules utilized with large international 3-second area. Games are 2 x 20 or 4 x 10 stop clock with real officials. Local host organizations recruit international teams unless stated as camp teams.

ADDENDUM:

- Please note when you look at the brochures from EF TOURS you will see many prices.
- The price offered is the price quoted in the shaded box at the bottom of the page based on 35+ paying people.
- Please note at the top of the page it gives a departure city. You can estimate your departure price by measuring the difference in price between the NYC, CHICAGO, and SFO.

USING EFTOURS:

- You will receive an email asking you to pay your deposit on Paypal.
- Your next payment will not be due until we confirm we have 35 people going on your trip and your trip price is valid, then you will each be asked to register at www.EFtours.com with the appropriate group number and password.
- Your coach will be listed as a chaperone and will not pay when registering at EF.
- The tournament fees are then paid to ABN by October 1 and each individual arranges payment with EFtours.
- If you do not want to use EFTOURS simply send fill out the registration form and an email will come back to you telling you how much your deposit is. The balance of your tournament fees is due October 1st.
- Per person fees can be adjusted at the time of departure—no problems.
- You may still add on meals at the camps, etc. In some cities, we can quote you hotel prices right next to the playing facility. We do not book or do any work for you, but we ask a 10% gratuity on the price for this service. You will pay all your own bills.
